

OEUK ASBESTOS TRANSPARENCY

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WHAT HAPPENED

During a planned HSE industrial hygiene inspection on CPC, a shortcoming was identified in the management of asbestos-containing materials (ACMs).



The regulator observed no written plan was in place to manage the risks, nor was there evidence that such a plan was being regularly reviewed and updated.



Due to insufficient compliance for asbestos management planning, the HSE issued a formal Improvement Notice.

WHAT WENT WRONG

-  Limited understanding of asbestos across business
-  Ineffective contractor management
-  Lack of effective information management
-  Ineffective listening
